1. Find and introduce yourself to your students.
2. Ask your student what their goals are for the day.
3. Obtain the Student Evaluation form.
4. (Group One) Take your student on the track ride in your vehicle; have your vehicle parked in the Hot Pit lane prior to the drivers meeting.
5. (Group One) Immediately after the track ride, get to your students car and proceed to the Car Control Course.
6. Always be on time to pre-grid.
7. Fill out the Student Evaluation immediately following session #1.
8. If you have your race car for lunch, please offer a ride to your students.
(Couple laps will go along ways)
9. Fill out the Student Evaluation forms after the final session.
10. Sign your student's certificate.
11. Come to certificate presentations.
12. If you are having trouble with a student, please come see me and we will try to find a solution. (Maybe switching instructors, I must be involved)
