STAR Projects is again offering both our **Annual Instructor Training** and **Worker Training** event at Oregon Raceway Park. To address the specifics of each specialty, divided morning classrooms are combined in the afternoon with on course practice in real time.

The cost to cover the **Instructor Training** is \$225. **Worker Training is FREE** for all who wish to attend. Your lunch and gate pass for the day are included. The morning format consists of classroom(s), fire suppression practice, lunch, and a track orientation tour. Afternoon track time is split to allow drivers to refresh skills in both directions.

As in years past, the morning Instructor Training classroom will be run concurrently but separately from the Worker Training classroom. Both groups will combine before lunch to familiarize worker recruits with many of the vehicle safety systems and how to best assist drivers with response and egress during emergency situations.

Since endurance racing events are again scheduled for the 2025 season the Turn Worker curriculum will include familiarization with racing protocols as well as the general procedures required for staffing turns, event flow, and communication required for Club Days, H.P.D.E., Schools, and Private Testing events.

Participation in training does not guarantee placement as a **Turn Worker** or qualification as a **Driving Instructor**, however it bears heavily on the selection process. This is the first step to becoming eligible for dual occupancy of a vehicle and those interested in becoming paid members of the 2025 O.R.P. Staff. Instructor candidates and returning instructors please file or update your resume with Brenda at the track office.

Whether a seasoned veteran Turn Marshal, or new to the road racing environment, YOU are welcome. Due to the need to plan meals and arrange facilities I urge all participants to sign up as soon as possible.

Whether **Turn Worker** or **Driving Instructor** you are the front line, the people making our sport happen. We continually strive to improve our game. **We learn from each other.** Come and participate.



WANTED: COURSE SUPPORT PERSONNEL

O.R.P. has openings for the 2025 season! Watch the races and get paid for it too.

Candidates must be 18 years of age, and have the ability to:

- Be outdoors (sometimes in harsh conditions).
- Possess alert observational skills and have the ability to communicate clearly.
- Be able to react calmly and quickly to emergency situations.
- Work cooperatively with others in a team environment.

Duties vary but may include working corners as Course Marshal, Security, Crowd Control, and Facilities Maintenance and can develop into other specialties. We offer a great opportunity to learn procedures related to race track event operation and grow personal skills at one of the most technically challenging tracks in the nation.

At O.R.P. we welcome prior experience, but are proud of the high standard attained by many of our workers through our in-house training program. Most days start with cars on course at 9:00 a.m. and end with a cold track at 5:00 p.m. A free lunch is included midday. During multiple day back to back bookings and endurance races we are occasionally ask to provide extended hours, but that rarely happens.
